

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF HUMAN SERVICES
GILPIN COUNTY, COLORADO

January 26, 2010

A regular meeting of the Board of Human Services of Gilpin County was held on January 26, 2010, at the Gilpin County Old Courthouse. Chair Buddy Schmalz called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. In attendance were Chair Buddy Schmalz; Commissioner Jeanne Nicholson and Commissioner Forrest Whitman; County Attorney Jim Petrock; County Manager Roger Baker; and Deputy Clerk to the Board Sharon Cate.

Public Hearing—Community Services Block Grant. Chair Schmalz opened a public hearing for the Community Services Block Grant application. Gilpin County Human Services Director Betty Donovan presented the application saying the funds are used exclusively for the County food bank and that in 2009 Gilpin County had received a \$5,000 grant award. She also noted that her department's application included demographics portraying the sharp increase in the food stamp caseload since the year 2000.

Chair Schmalz opened the hearing to public comment. There being none, Chair Schmalz closed that portion of the hearing. Commissioner Nicholson moved to approve the application for a Community Services Block Grant. Commissioner Whitman seconded the motion, which passed by a vote of 3 to 0. Chair Schmalz closed the public hearing.

Reports. Director Donovan summarized the October 2009 report on operations in the Human Services Department and the Calendar Year 2009 Expenditures report as well. The Board of Human Services commended her for the improvements to the format of her reports and directed her to attach comparison reports for the previous month and year.

Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the Board, they adjourned at 9:25 a.m.
