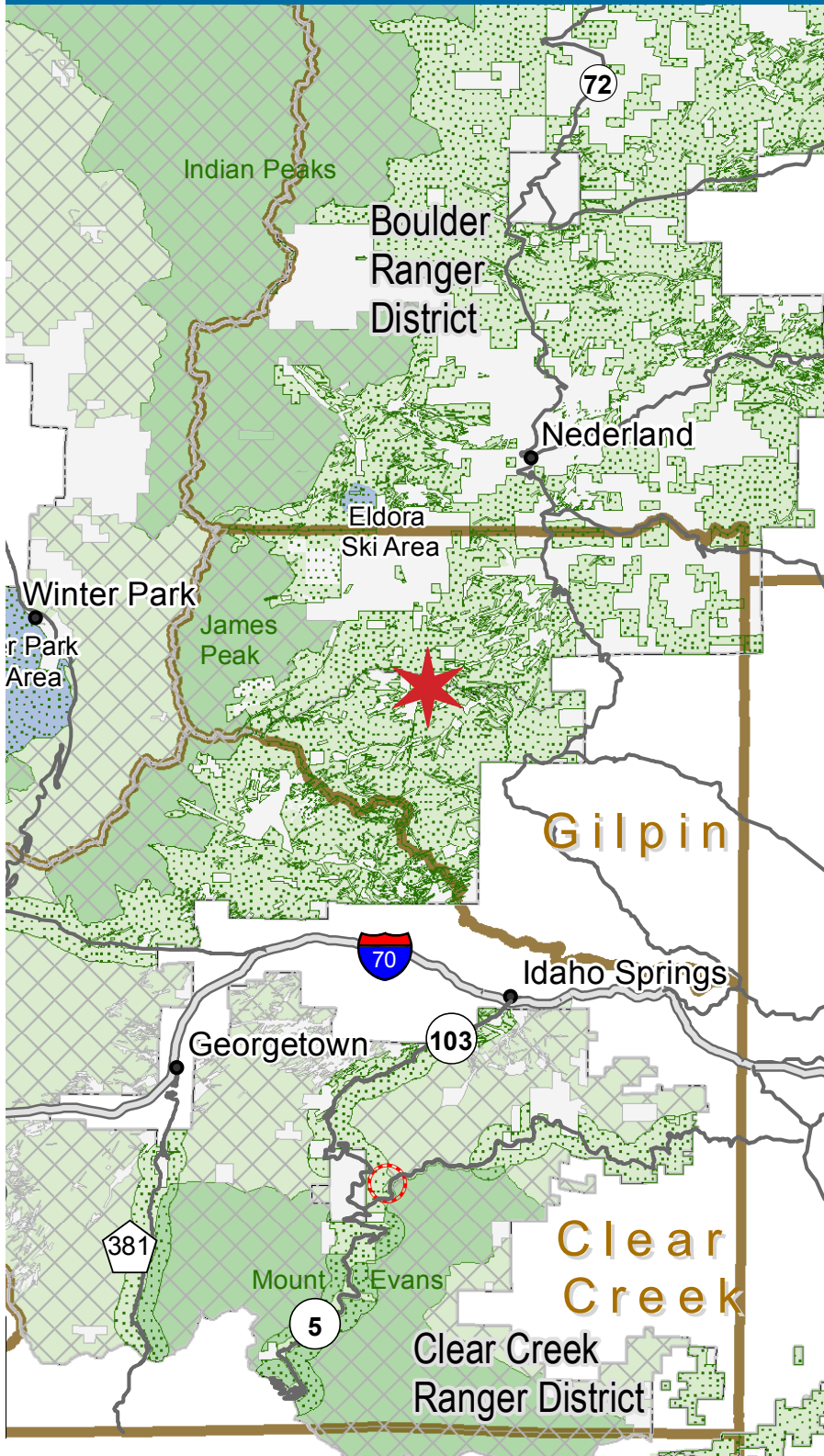


COMMUNITY MEETING
