# **Case Management**

Provided by the Older Americans Act

In the Denver region, many people will seek assistance to remain independent in their own homes. And that's where the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG), the region's Area Agency on Aging, comes in to help you.

- 1. DRCOG provides intensive short-term, Case Management services for people 60 and older.**
  - You will receive a comprehensive needs assessment. Based on this assessment, you and your Case Manager will develop a Care Plan together.
  - You will receive assistance with coordinating and monitoring services to ensure peace of mind for everyone involved.
- 2. We provide health care advocacy.**
  - When appropriate, you will be connected with necessary medical, non-medical and mental health professionals.
  - You may also receive counseling about benefits eligibility, and additional assistance with applications as needed.
- 3. We help you remain active and independent.**
  - If necessary, you will receive help reviewing financial and legal issues that may be impacting your ability to remain independent.
  - You may also be referred to resources for assistive devices such as medical equipment and home modifications to ensure a safe living environment.
  - Finally, you could be connected with caregiver support programs, respite care, or socialization options to decrease social isolation.
