The date for the upcoming public comment hearing focused on CNG's request for a rider to increase customer rates to cover necessary repairs is **Monday, March 8, 2021 starting at 3:30 p.m., MST**. Participants should refer to Commission Proceeding No. 20A-0284G when submitting their written comments.

It would be super helpful if they would pass my letter on to their constituents so we can get as many public comments in as soon as possible to make sure that CNG's ratepayers, who already pay two-and-half times more for their natural gas than Xcel Energy customers, are not forced to carry the cost of these repairs.
