

## SUMMARY OF GILPIN COUNTY PHO 20-14 ADOPTING CDPHE PHO 20-36 COVID-19 DIAL – LEVEL ORANGE (HIGH RISK)

### Capacity Limits

- **Public and private gatherings:** 10 individuals from no more than 2 households. No limits on gatherings of individuals from same household. These capacity limits also apply to short-term rental properties.
- **Businesses and Activities:** Percent of posted occupancy limit, applicable not to exceed amount, and related restrictions:
  - **Casinos** (excluding staff): 25% up to 50 people per indoor space.
  - **Restaurants** (excluding staff): Indoors - 25% with max party size of 10 up to 50 people per room; Outdoors allowed if permitted by County or Cities with max party size of 10 with total number of patrons allowed based on 6 feet distancing spacing requirements. Restaurants may also provide takeout, delivery, or curbside service.
  - **Smoking Lounges:** 25% not to exceed 10 people.
  - **Houses of Worship and outdoor services** (excluding staff): Indoor 25% up to 50 people per room. Outdoor events subject to prior County approval of event capacity in designated space to ensure 6-feet distancing.
  - **Personal Services** (personal training, hair stylists, manicurists, dog grooming, pastoral services, massage therapists, etc...): 25% up to 25 people per room
  - **Indoor Events** (excluding staff): 25% up to 50 people per room, excluding staff, if distancing complies with [Distancing Calculator](#) requirements or if seated event with 6-foot distancing.
  - **Outdoor Events** (excluding staff): 25% up to 75 people, excluding staff, per designated space if distancing complies with [Distancing Calculator](#) requirements or if seated event with 6-foot distancing.
  - **Recreation including Gyms, Recreation Centers and Indoor Pools and Outdoor Recreation** (excluding staff): Indoors 25% up to 25 people per room, activity, or designated outdoor area. Outdoor groups limited 10 people with 6 feet distancing between non-household contacts.
  - **Children's Camps:** 10 people outdoors. **Indoors prohibited.**
  - **Organized Recreational Youth and Adult League Sports:** 10 people, excluding coaches, referees, and umpires
  - **Field Services:** no limits other than for real estate open houses which must follow limits for Indoor Events.
  - **Critical Businesses and Critical Government Functions:** No limits. (Critical Businesses include: gas stations, convenience stores, marijuana dispensaries for medical marijuana sales or curbside delivery for other products, liquor stores for takeout, curbside, or delivery services).
  - **Non-critical Office-based Business:** 25%

### Distancing Requirements

- 6 feet. See [Distancing Calculator](#) for space required to allow movement while maintaining 6 feet distancing.
- 25 feet between performers and restaurant or bar patrons
- 50 feet between sporting event fields of play and spectators

### Alcohol Services – Bars and Restaurants (including in Casinos)

- Bars not serving food inhouse from licensed retail food establishment are **closed** to indoor service. Outside delivery pick-up via curbside or otherwise is allowed subject to distancing requirements.
- Alcohol sales for on-premises consumption or take out prohibited between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. MDT.

### Facial Coverings

- Facial coverings required on **ALL** Gilpin County government indoor and outdoor property.
- Facial coverings required in **ALL** public indoor spaces.
- Facial coverings strongly encouraged everywhere else.

### Additional Requirements

- Casinos must comply with additional requirements set out in APPENDIX 2 to Amendment 1 to Gilpin County PHO 20-14 including CLOSING ALL TABLE GAMES.
- Remote working, staying home when sick, limiting gatherings to only those in your household, and limiting travel to only Necessary Travel are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** for everyone.
- All Businesses and Government Functions must implement disease prevention measures including designating staff to oversee compliance, implement adequate cleaning and disinfecting measures (see [Cleaning Measures](#) and [CDPHE Guidelines](#)), implement screening protocols, provide adequate PPE (facial coverings etc...) and hand sanitizer, maintain adequate spacing and provide marked spacing and signage to assist compliance, provide information electronically to the extent possible to avoid transmission via paper or physical touch, and ensure adequate ventilation.
