

NOTICE OF ELECTION (C.R.S. 1-5-205)

Gilpin County Coordinated Election, November 1, 2011, Mail Ballot Election

Ballots will be mailed to all ACTIVE voters in Gilpin County. Ballots shall be returned to the Gilpin County Clerk and Recorder, Colleen Stewart, P.O. Box 429, Central City, CO 80427.

Walk-ins can surrender their mail ballot and vote electronically at the County Clerk's Office in the Old Courthouse in Central City, 203 Eureka St. The office hours are 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday thru Friday. Replacement ballots will also be available. An inactive voter may request a ballot by coming into the Clerk's Office or calling 303-582-5321 for more information.

Hours of operation on Election Day will be 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. All ballots MUST be received by 7:00 P.M. on November 1, 2011.

The ballot for all Gilpin County voters will contain Proposition 103 listed below:

**Proposition 103 (STATUTORY)**

SHALL STATE TAXES BE INCREASED \$536.1 MILLION ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR AND BY SUCH AMOUNTS AS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY AMENDMENTS TO THE COLORADO REVISED STATUTES CONCERNING A TEMPORARY INCREASE IN CERTAIN STATE TAXES FOR ADDITIONAL PUBLIC EDUCATION FUNDING, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, INCREASING THE RATE OF THE STATE INCOME TAX IMPOSED ON ALL TAXPAYERS FROM 4.63% TO 5% FOR THE 2012 THROUGH 2016 INCOME TAX YEARS; INCREASING THE RATE OF THE STATE SALES AND USE TAX FROM 2.9% TO 3% FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS COMMENCING ON JANUARY 1, 2012; REQUIRING THAT THE ADDITIONAL REVENUES RESULTING FROM THESE INCREASED TAX RATES BE SPENT ONLY TO FUND PUBLIC EDUCATION FROM PRESCHOOL THROUGH TWELFTH GRADE AND PUBLIC POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION; SPECIFYING THAT THE APPROPRIATION OF THE ADDITIONAL TAX REVENUES BE IN ADDITION TO AND NOT

SUBSTITUTED FOR MONEYS OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED FOR PUBLIC EDUCATION FROM PRESCHOOL THROUGH TWELFTH GRADE AND PUBLIC POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION FOR THE 2011-12 FISCAL YEAR; AND ALLOWING THE ADDITIONAL TAX REVENUES TO BE COLLECTED, KEPT, AND SPENT NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LIMITATIONS PROVIDED BY LAW?
